Assoc.Prof. Fahriye Oflaz (PhD., RN) has been a faculty member at the Psychiatric and Mental Health Nursing Department at Koç University School of Nursing in Istanbul.

She participated into postdoctoral program at Johns Hopkins University, School of Nursing between 2003-2004. She had been faculty member from that time until 2010 at GMMA School of Nursing. After retiring military service in 2012 she worked at Nursing Departments of Yeditepe University and Okan University,.
